Nordisk Film & TV Fond Prize jury announced

The jury members for the NOK 200,000 (€ 20,000) Nordic TV Drama Screenplay Award 2021 are now official.

For the fifth consecutive year, the award for outstanding writing of a Nordic drama series, funded by Nordisk Film & TV Fond, will be handed out during TV Drama Vision, Göteborg Film Festival's conference event and series market.

This year's Nordisk Film & TV Fond Prize jury members comprise the Israeli Emmy Award-winning producer and Head of International Content Development at The Mediapro Studio **Ran Tellem** (*Homeland, The Head*), Danish Festival Director of THIS - Future Stories & Engagement and Aarhus Series **Felicia Elisabeth Jackson**, and acclaimed Swedish actor **Evin Ahmad** (*The Rain, Beyond Dreams, Snabba Cash* reboot).

As previously announced, five Nordic drama series have been selected as the 2021 nominees for the prestigious script award. The winner will be announced at an award ceremony on February 3 during the 2021 online edition of TV Drama Vision.
